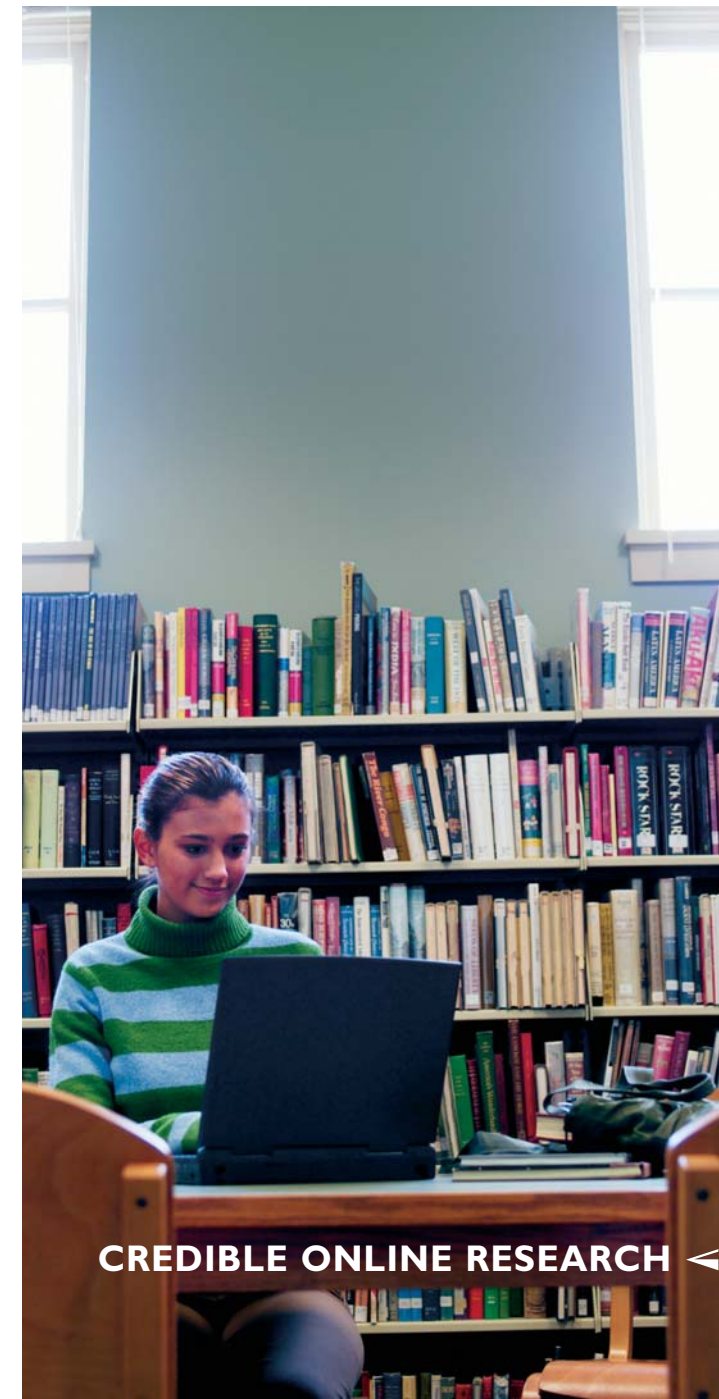

ANY COLLEGE

Students and faculty at Utah's public and private colleges and universities gain access to Pioneer Online Library through the Utah Academic Library Consortium. You can access a variety of resources including databases, indexes and electronic journals.

Most participating colleges and universities also provide home access to registered students and faculty with a password. Contact your college and university librarian for your password.



ANY SCHOOL

Students and educators at Utah's 820 public schools can access Pioneer Online Library through their school Internet connections. Pioneer Library is also available to privately-run schools in Utah through the Independent Schools Librarians of Utah. Students can access specific EBSCO resources for middle school, junior high and high school.

Educators, students and their families can access Pioneer Online Library from Internet-connected home computers with a password available from their school librarian or the Utah Education Network at 1-800-866-5852.



ANY LIBRARY

Anyone can access Pioneer Online Library through any of Utah's 125 public libraries statewide. While Pioneer Library's school and college databases are targeted to the needs of students and educators, Pioneer's public library databases range from hobbies and car repair to government and business information.

Access these resources at your public library or from an Internet-connected computer with your library card number or access code from your local public library.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ARE ALL PIONEER ONLINE LIBRARY SERVICES AVAILABLE FROM ANY LOCATION?

No. Pioneer Online Library resources span grade levels from pre-kindergarten to graduate studies. Not all resources for college students are available to public schools students and vice versa. Access to some of Pioneer Library's premium databases requires your library card **or** your student ID card. Check with your public or school librarian for more information about the databases you can access and which credentials you'll need to access them.

DOES PIONEER ONLINE LIBRARY OFFER AGE-APPROPRIATE REFERENCES FOR STUDENTS?

Yes. Pioneer Online Library's databases for young children include *WorldBook Online*, *EBSCO Searchasaurus* and a kids section of *CultureGrams*. Pioneer Online Library also provides specific EBSCO resources for middle school, junior high and high school students. Pioneer Library's additional databases for college students include *Academic Search Premier*, *MasterFILE Premier*, *American Chemical Society journals*, *MEDLINE* and *ProQuest Newspapers*.

WHO PAYS FOR PIONEER ONLINE LIBRARY?

As a taxpayer, you do through a combination of state and federal taxes. The Pioneer Online Library consortium of school, college and public libraries delivers a substantial cost savings to taxpayers. For example, individual school districts, colleges or library systems would pay seven to seventy times more per user without Pioneer Online Library's statewide contracts with premium database providers.
