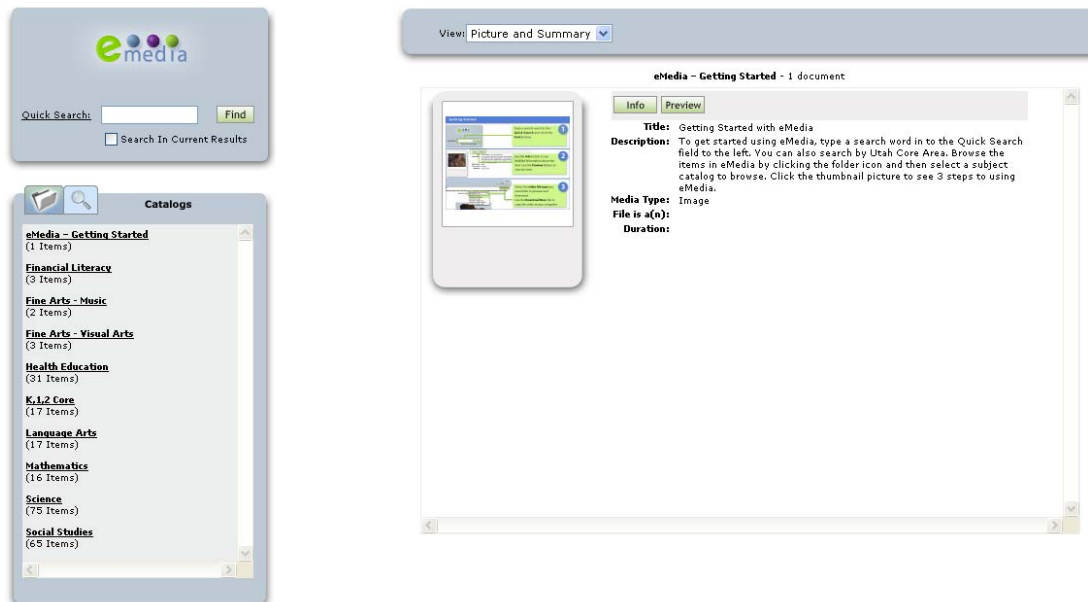
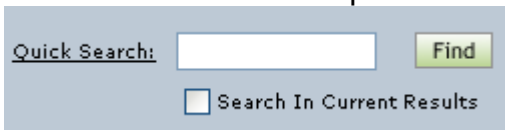

This resource was created by UEN and UIMC (Utah Instructional Media Consortium) for Utah teachers to provide them with valuable access to multimedia resources. The database contains over 200 clips and entire films provided by educational organizations. Most importantly, the eMedia interface is quite simple to use.

There are two search options with eMedia. You can perform a **Quick Search**

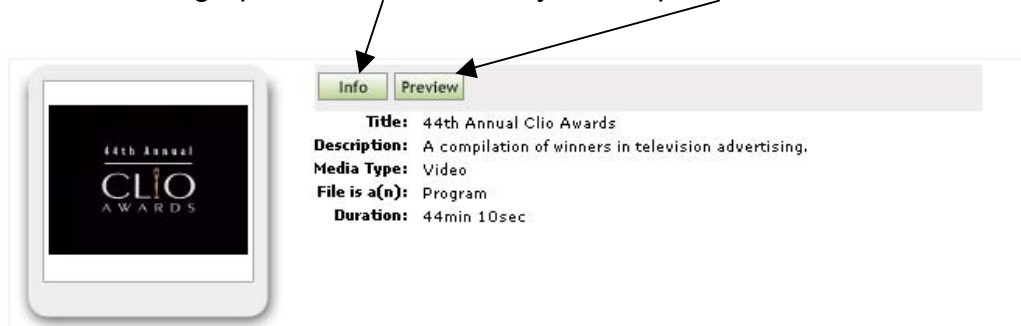


by using keywords in the search field at the top of the page. The quick search will help you find videos and clips from all curriculum areas that relate to your keyword.

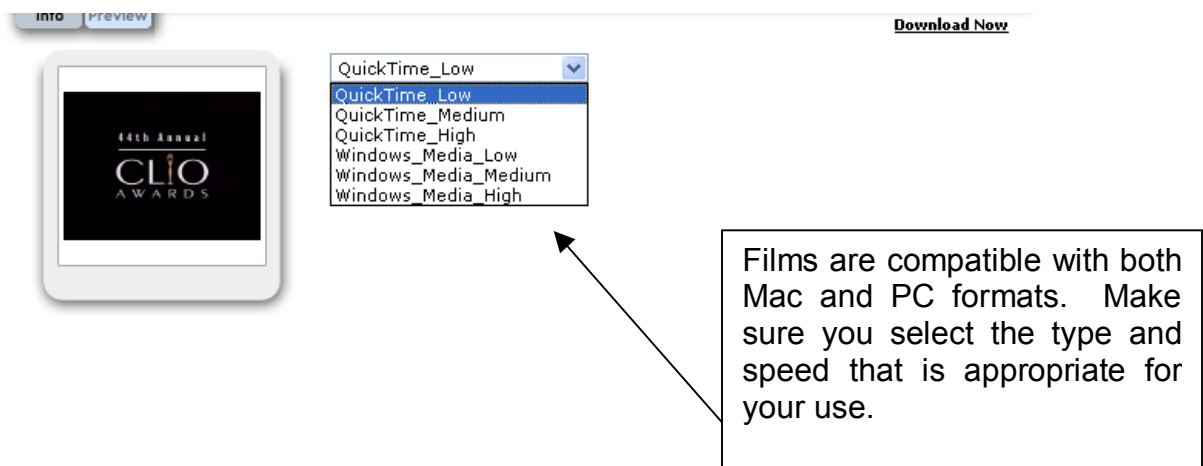
You can also perform a search directly from a content area catalog. Searching can be done either by clicking on the content area and reviewing the information

for each film or clicking on the magnifying glass icon  to perform an advanced search.

Once you have found a film that meets your needs, you have two options. You can review the bibliographic information and you can preview the film.



When you open a film selection, you see a screen capture of the film, a menu for the type of format in which to view the film and a button providing you with the opportunity to download the film to your school or personal computer to use in future presentations.



eMedia is a growing resource in the Pioneer Library. Spend some time exploring and be sure to come back for many visits. New resources will continually be added to eMedia and the Pioneer Library.
